# **Priority areas for action - 1**

---

- 1. The financial burden on companies should be reduced both on the short and the long term.**
  
- 2. Consistent European chemicals legislation needs to be guaranteed.**

- 3. The quality of guidance about industry's REACH obligations should be improved to avoid legal uncertainty.**
- 4. Truly harmonised REACH rules accrosss Member States should be ensured, especially in terms of enforcement.**
