Aims of the campaign



- SIEFs formed and Lead Registrants nominated

- Submission of all dossiers before the deadline

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Campaign elements

- Trying to remove the barriers
- Raising awareness of the urgency

Removing the barriers

- Developing clearer lines and recommendations
- Translation of key materials
 - SIEF webpages
 - SIEF top tips
 - Guidance documents
- Helpdesk support – from 3000 in 2 weeks to 600 responses a month



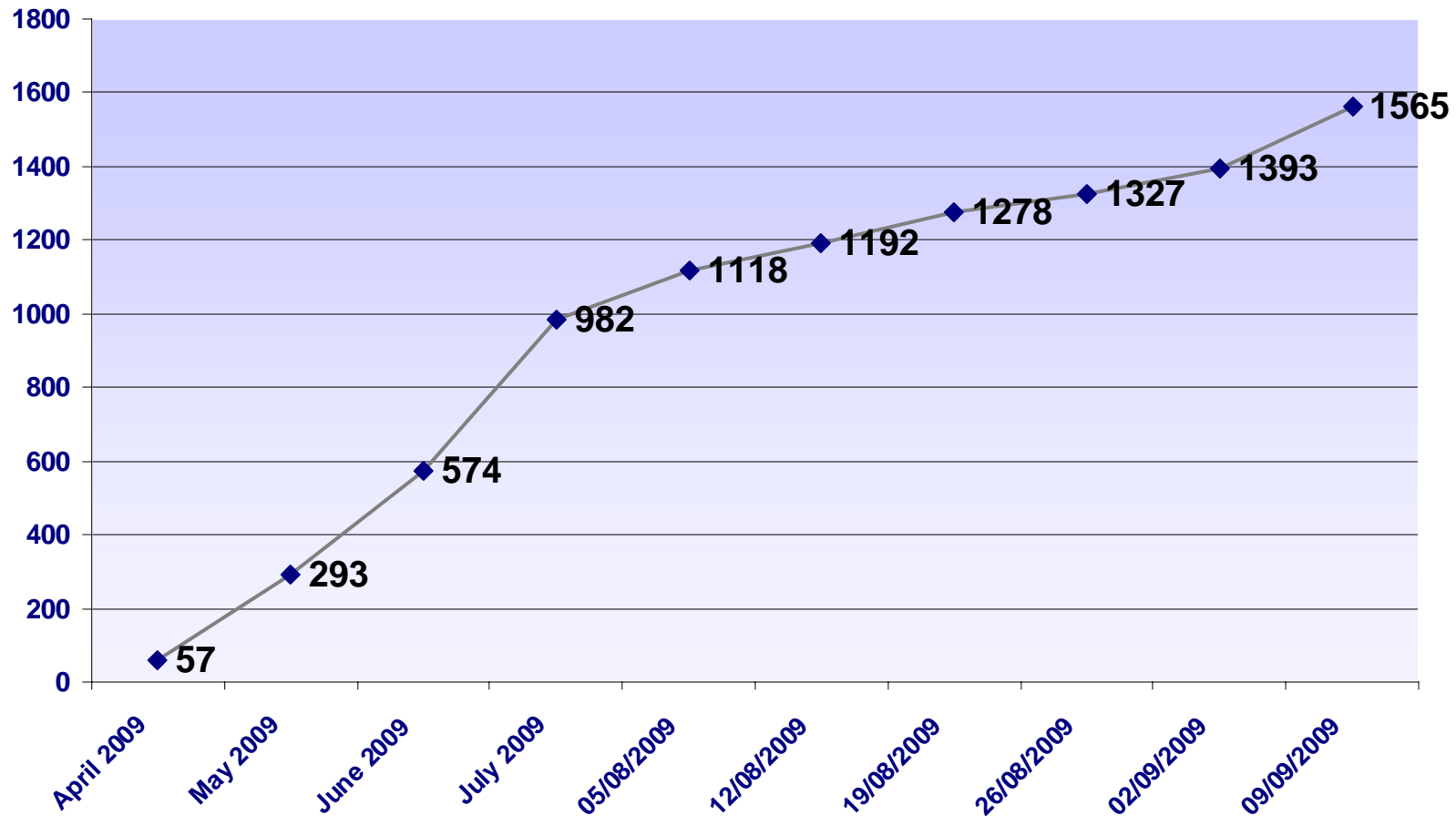
- Clarification on Guidance documents and FAQs

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Registrations too

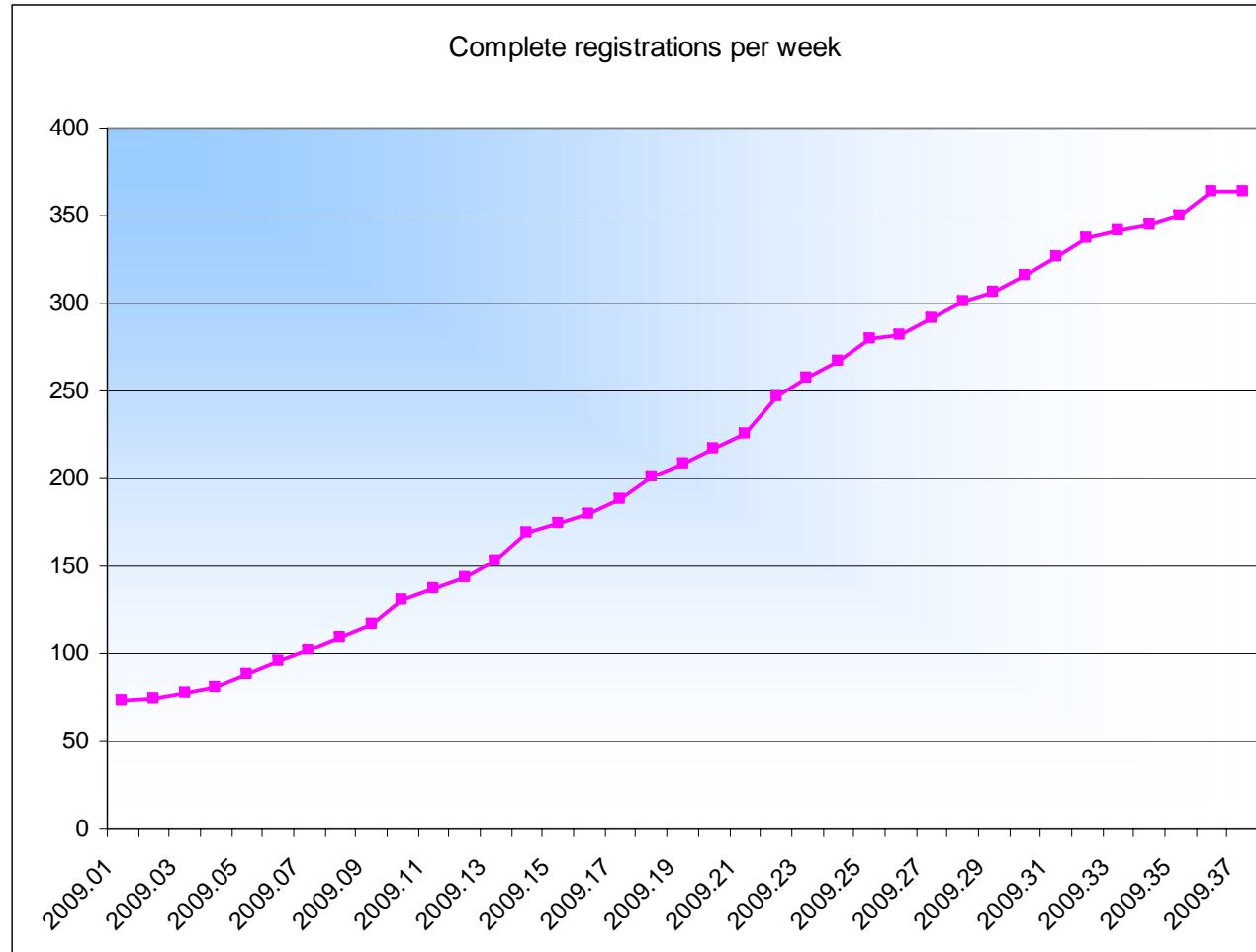
- 240 registration dossiers for phase-in substances received already
