- GES need to be checked for relevance and applicability with the DU
 - Does it make sense??
 - Is it realistic?
 - Are included estimates appropriate?
- Metal-, chain-, hazard-, DU- specificities will be considered at this stage...moving from GES to ES



Step C. First draft GES to be checked by a sector

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First draft GES to M/I and DU

- First draft GES as prepared by Consortium secretariat/Consultants
 - a description of the process operational conditions and details of the potential routes of exposure associated with the generic process.
 - quantitative estimates on exposure levels based on models (ART, EUSES, ECETOC-TRA,...)
 - Humans (inhalation, dermal, oral)
 - Environment (air, water, soil, sediment)
 - generic risk management measures (BREF notes, COSHH essentials, RIF, RMM library,...)
- Consortium secretariat to distribute draft GESs to
 - Consortium members (M/I) - all
 - DU sector association – sector specific

First draft GES to M/I and DU

- DU Sector association → members
- Company X to follow-up with its customers
- Objective: BASIS FOR DISCUSSION
 - Are all uses and processes of the sector covered?
 - If not, provide info for missing scenario
 - Check relevance, applicability, realistic? Are the RMMs, OC and estimated exposures appropriate for the sector?
 - If not, provide relevant information
 - Exposure monitoring data
 - Operational Conditions
 - RMM
